is intended for practising executives with a strong management background, seeking to upgrade their level of training to become more versatile in their duties and better able to assume greater organizational responsibility.


A **UNIQUE** PROGRAM

CONDITIONS FOR ADMISSION

Fall and winter admissions

Currently employed with at least 4 years of executive experience (2 years if candidate has master's degree, 1 year with doctorate).

Bachelor's degree with a cumulative **grade point average of 3.2 out of 4.3**.

A bachelor's degree with a GPA between **2.7 and 3.2** might be accepted, however additional years of experience will be required. For a bachelor's degree with a GPA **lower than 2.7**, an **additional 15 credits** with a GPA of **3.2 out of 4.3** will also be required.

In exceptional circumstances, an applicant with no Bachelor's degree may be admitted (maximum 10% of admissions).

Applicants must provide a standard admission application form, a letter of motivation, 3 letters of recommendation, a current CV and proof of employment.

Mandatory interview (held mid-October to mid-December, and mid-April to mid-June).

Preparatory courses and language proficiency testing may be required.
